

PATHFINDER DISTRICT SCOUTER AWARD NOMINATION FORM

The Pathfinder District has established three adult leader awards to be granted to registered Scouters from the district for service to Scouting. While no minimum tenure is required for this recognition, the candidate must demonstrate service to the movement over an extended period of time. These awards are recognition for unit people who do not have the District Award of Merit or the Silver Beaver Award.

Accordingly, the three awards shall be:

- A) **UNIT LEADER AWARD** – Cubmasters, Scoutmasters, and/or Explorer Advisors only qualify for this award.
- B) **SCOUTER LEADERSHIP AWARD** – Any adult working with any phase of the Boy Scout program other than Cubbing but not in the position of Unit Leader.
- C) **CUB LEADERSHIP AWARD** – Any adult working with any phase of the Cub program other than Cubmaster.

The following rules will govern nominations for these awards:

- 1) All nominations must be submitted on this form only. Additional information and/or comments may be attached to this application.
- 2) Someone other than the person being nominated must complete nominations. Scouters cannot nominate themselves. It is recommended that Scouters being nominated not be told they are.
- 3) Nominations will not be carried over from previous years. Only Scouters nominated for the current year's awards will be considered.
- 4) Nominations must be submitted to the District Awards Committee in order to be considered for the current year's award.
